RAISING MONEY TO IMPROVE ROAD SAFETY IN DIGSWELL

It's 30 for a reason... a pedestrian is approximately four times more likely to die when hit at 40mph than at 30mph. Recent traffic studies have proven that each day approximately 750 cars speed through Digswell in excess of 35mph, with top speeds in excess of 60mph. After taking into account Digswell's narrow pavements, this puts all pedestrians, especially our school children, at great risk.

The DRA and the Governing Body of the School have been working with the Police, Local Councillor and MP to tackle this issue. Although sympathetic and supportive of our cause, we do not qualify for funding for additional traffic calming measures simply because there haven't been 4 serious incidents within the last 3 years. **Therefore, we need your help to raise the money.**
